- \_\_\_ 15. My child is able to play on my emotions in order to get what he wants.
- \_\_\_ 16. I hesitate to say "no" to my child out of fear of what he might do.

- \_\_\_ 17. I am unsuccessful at completing the intended instruction and discipline of my child due to his unwillingness to cooperate.
- \_\_\_ 18. My child is so tenacious in wanting his own way that I either give in to his desires or give up on trying to train him.
- \_\_\_ 19. My child continues to beg and plead to have his own way after I have denied his appeal the first time.
- \_\_\_ 20. My child is more disobedient and disrespectful in front of others than he is when he knows that such behavior is not likely to embarrass me.
